Regulation of martial arts instruction. A. Any city with a population between 250,000 and 270,000 or between 150,000 and 160,000 may by ordinance require any person who operates a business providing martial arts instruction to have at the

10 ordinance require any person who operates a business providing martial arts instruction to have at the site where instruction is taking place a person who has current certification or, within the last two 11 12 years, has received training in emergency first aid and cardio-pulmonary resuscitation.

- 13 Any person who violates such an ordinance may be subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$50 for 14
- the first violation and \$100 for any subsequent violation. B. As used in this section, "martial arts instruction" means any course of instruction for self defense, 15 16 such as judo or karate.
