9	WHEREAS, among Virginia's least-known treasures are the eight covered bridges that remain
10	standing in the Commonwealth; and
11	WHEREAS, constructed between the 1850s and the 1920s, these uniquely attractive and evocative
12	structures traverse creeks and rivers in the Shenandoah Valley, the Allegheny Mountains, Southwest
13	Virginia, and Southside; and
14	WHEREAS, the oldest, Humpback Covered Bridge, was built in 1857 and crosses Dunlap Creek near
15	Covington in Alleghany County, while the newest, Bob White Covered Bridge, was built in 1921 over
16	the Smith River in Patrick County; and
17	WHEREAS, the small Giles County community of Newport can boast of three covered bridges in its
18	immediate vicinity, the Links Farm, the C. K. Reynolds, and the Sinking Creek Covered Bridges, all of
19	which cross Sinking Creek; and
20	WHEREAS, the Biedler Farm Covered Bridge in Rockingham County, the Meems Bottom Covered
21	Bridge in Shenandoah County, and the Jack's Creek Covered Bridge in Patrick County complete the list
22	of Virginia's covered bridges; and
23	WHEREAS, sadly, Virginia's stock of covered bridges was reduced by one in 1996, when Hurricane
24	Fran wiped out the Marysville Covered Bridge in Campbell County; and
25	WHEREAS, these extraordinary structures form a little-known but nonetheless invaluable and
26	irreplaceable part of Virginia's historic heritage; now, therefore, be it
27	RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby
28	designate the third weekend in June, in 1998 and in each succeeding [even-numbered] year, as
29	Covered Bridge Weekend in Virginia; and, be it
30	RESOLVED FURTHER, That the General Assembly urge the citizens of the Commonwealth to learn
31	about these historic bridges, visit them where feasible, and support efforts, public or private, to restore

and maintain Virginia's covered bridges [; and, be it RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit a copy of this resolution to the Chief Executive Officer of the Virginia Tourism Corporation in order that he may be apprised of the sense of the General Assembly in this matter]. 33 34 35
