19	1968 and served for more than 11 years, including a term as chairman from 1977 to 1979; and
20	WHEREAS, while a member of the school board, Thomas Beane was on the board of directors of
21	the Virginia School Boards Association; and
22	WHEREAS, appointed to the Prince William County Electoral Board in 1981, Thomas Beane served
23	for 16 years, including terms as secretary and chairman; and
24	WHEREAS, Thomas Beane was for many years a member of the Manassas Kiwanis Club, which he
25	served as president in 1972-73, and was a longtime member of the Prince William County Bar
26	Association, serving as president in 1980; and
27	WHEREAS, Thomas Beane has combined a successful law career with a wide variety of
28 29	community-service activities, to the benefit of the citizens of Prince William County; now, therefore, be it
