An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.804, 58.1-3650.805, and 58.1-3650.806, designating certain property to be exempt from taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 58.1-3650.804, 58.1-3650.805, and 58.1-3650.806 as follows:
 - § 58.1-3650.804. Property of American Type Culture Collection.
- A. American Type Culture Collection, a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a religious, charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6 (a) (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located in Prince William County, which is owned by American Type Culture Collection and used by it exclusively for religious, charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
 - § 58.1-3650.805. Property of Lakeview Swim Club, Inc.
- A. Lakeview Swim Club, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as an organization providing a public park and playground within the context of Section 6 (a) (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located in Fairfax County at 5352 Gainsborough Drive and identified by Fairfax County Tax Map Number 69-3, ((5)), Parcel M, which is owned by Lakeview Swim Club, Inc., and used by it exclusively for public park and playground purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
 - § 58.1-3650.806. Property of Rainbow Center 4-H Therapeutic Equestrian Program, Inc.
- A. Rainbow Center 4-H Therapeutic Equestrian Program, Inc., a nonprofit organization, is hereby designated as a religious, charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6 (a) (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia.
- B. Property located in Prince William County, which is owned by Rainbow Center 4-H Therapeutic Equestrian Program, Inc., and used by it exclusively for religious, charitable and benevolent purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation.
