CHAPTER 828

An Act to amend and reenact § 63.1-248.5:1.01 of the Code of Virginia, relating to falsely reporting child abuse; penalty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

- 1. That § 63.1-248.5:1.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - § 63.1-248.5:1.01. Knowingly making false reports; penalties.
- A. Any person fourteen years of age or older who makes or causes to be made a report of child abuse or neglect pursuant to this chapter which he knows to be false shall be guilty of a Class 4 *I* misdemeanor. Any person fourteen years of age or older who has been previously convicted under this subsection and who is subsequently convicted of making a false report of child abuse or neglect under this subsection shall be guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor 6 felony.
- B. The child protective services records regarding the person who was alleged to have committed abuse or neglect which result from a report for which a conviction is obtained under this section shall be purged immediately by any custodian of such records upon presentation to the custodian of a certified copy of such conviction. After purging the records, the custodian shall notify the person in writing that such records have been purged.
- 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0.
