| 16 | of less than twenty years, he shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony. Any If a person age eighteen or older |
| 17 | who commands, entreats, or otherwise attempts to persuade another person under age eighteen to |
| 18 | commit: (i) a felony which is punishable by a term of imprisonment of twenty years or more, he shall |
| 19 | be guilty of a Class 4 felony; or (ii) a felony which is punishable by a maximum term of imprisonment |
