15	under this chapter. Every registered check casher shall give written notice to the Commission, within ten
16	days thereafter, of the opening, closing or relocation of an office.
17	§ 6.1-435. Registration; regulation.
18	The An application for registration shall be accompanied by a payment of a \$200 registration
19	application fee, which shall not be refundable or abated in any event. In order to defray the costs of
20	their examination, supervision and regulation, every check casher required to be registered under this
21	chapter shall pay to the Commission annually on or before July 1 a registration fee in an amount
