Patrons-Morgan and Keating 8 Referred to Committee on Corporations, Insurance and Banking 9 10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 6.1-194.12 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 § 6.1-194.12. Certificate of authority to do business. 12 A. Before any organizing state association may begin business in the Commonwealth, it shall obtain 13 14 from the Commission a certificate of authority to do so, and prior to the issuance of such certificate the 15 Commission shall ascertain that: 16 1. All applicable provisions of law have been complied with; 2. In a mutual association, deposits in a total amount deemed by the Commission to be sufficient to 17 warrant successful operation but not less than two million dollars, have been pledged or deposited and 18 19 that such deposits shall not be withdrawable for at least one year, or, in a stock association, that 20 financially responsible persons have subscribed for capital stock, and surplus and a reserve for operation 21 in an amount deemed by the Commission to be sufficient to warrant successful operation, provided that 22 the capital stock shall have a paid-in value of not less than two million dollars. The minimum capital 23 stock requirement under this subdivision shall apply in cases in which a state association is being 24 organized to begin business; it shall not be applicable when this section is referred to or used in 25 connection with the conversion of an operating savings institution or bank to a state association, or 26 when this section is used in connection with the reorganization of an operating state association under a 27 holding company: 3. Regulations governing directors of the association have been complied with; 4. The public interest will be served by the addition of the proposed savings institution facilities in the community where the savings institution is to be located; and 5. The officers and directors of the proposed savings institution are of (i) moral fitness, (ii) financial responsibility, and (iii) business ability. As used herein, "public interest" shall have the meaning set forth in subdivision 4 of subsection A of § 6.1-13. B. No certificate of authority shall be issued on or after June 1, 1973, unless the applicant for such certificate: 1. Submits evidence of being fully insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or other 38 federal insurance agency; or 39 2. Submits sufficient evidence of commitment by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or other 40 federal insurance agency that the applicant will be issued insurance of accounts immediately subsequent 41 to the issuance of the certificate of authority. The Commission may issue such certificate conditioned upon the fact that the association shall not 42 commence to do business until it is issued insurance of accounts by the Federal Deposit Insurance 43 Corporation or other federal insurance agency. 44 C. Any interested person may appeal to the Supreme Court of Virginia from any order of the 45 Commission granting or denying such certificate of authority. 46

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
