| 11       | 1. That § 33.1-191 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                              |
| 11<br>12 | § 33.1-191. Contracts.   |
| 13       | Every contractor whose bid is accepted shall, before commencing work, enter into a contract with the         |
| 14       | Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner, which shall fully set out the time when work shall                 |
| 15       | commence and when the contract shall be completed, as well as the time and manner for the payment            |
| 16       | for the work.  |
| 17       | Whenever any duly awarded contract's cost exceeds the original contract award by more than ten               |
| 18       | percent because of overruns, add-ons, design changes, or any other occurrence, except (i) labor disputes     |
| 19       | not caused by the contractor; (ii) riots; (iii) civil commotion or insurrection; (iv) war or warlike         |
| 20       | operations; (v) governmental restrictions, regulations or control; (vi) inability to obtain any materials or |
| 21       | services; (vii) fire or other casualties; (viii) acts of God; or (ix) forces not under the control or        |
| 22       | supervision of the contractor, then such contract shall be cancelled and the contract shall be rebid in      |

*supervision of the contractor,accordance with this chapter.*
