HOUSE BILL NO. 2048 Offered January 20, 1999

A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-838 and 46.2-839 of the Code of Virginia, relating to overtaking and passing vehicles.

Patrons—Weatherholtz, Black, Blevins and Davis

Referred to Committee on Transportation

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 46.2-838 and 46.2-839 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 46.2-838. Passing when overtaking a vehicle.

The driver of any vehicle overtaking another *motor* vehicle proceeding in the same direction shall pass at least two feet to the left of the overtaken vehicle and shall not again drive to the right side of the highway until safely clear of such overtaken vehicle, except as otherwise provided in this article.

§ 46.2-839. Passing bicycle, moped, or horse-drawn vehicle.

In approaching or passing a person riding a bicycle or, moped, or horse-drawn vehicle, the driver of a motor vehicle shall pass at a safe distance and at a reasonable speed.
