UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION AND TRUST FUND COMMISSION. § 9-379. Unemployment Compensation and Trust Fund Commission (it the Commission) is established as a legislative agency of the Commonwealth. The Commission shall study, report and make recommendations on issues of unemployment compensation and Virginia's Unemployment Trust Fund. § 9-330. Membership: terms; vacancies; chairman and vice chairman: compensation. A. The Commission shall consist of ten members as follows: five members from the House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House, and five members from the Senate, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections. B. All appointments to the Commission shall be for terms of four years. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term. Whenever any legislative member fails to retain his membership in the house from which he was appointed, he shall relinquish his membership on the Commission, and the authority that appointed such compensation as is set forth in § 30-19.12 and shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in the work of the Commission. § 9-381.
