12	1. That § 17.1-315 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 17.1-315. Duties of Executive Secretary.
14	The Executive Secretary to the Supreme Court shall have the following duties:
15	1. He shall be the Secretary of the Judicial Council;
16	2. He shall be the Secretary of the Judicial Conference;
17	3. He shall assist the Chief Justice and the Supreme Court in the administration of the judicial branch
18	of the government to the end that litigation may be expedited and the administration of justice improved
19	in the courts of the Commonwealth; and
20	4. He shall, on or before July 1, 2000, ensure that the Law Office and Public Access System or some
21	such similar electronic database which provides public access to the public records of the courts of this
$\overline{22}$	Commonwealth, is available free of charge through the global information system known as the Internet;
