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## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Title 22.1 a chapter numbered 11.2, consisting of 3 sections numbered 22.1-175.6 through 22.1-175.9, relating to the Virginia Public School Educational 4 Technology Grants Program and Trust Fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 22.1 a chapter numbered 11.2, 9 consisting of sections numbered 22.1-175.6 through 22.1-175.9, as follows: 10

CHAPTER 11.2. VIRGINIA PUBLIC SCHOOL EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY GRANTS PROGRAM

AND TRUST FUND.

§ 22.1-175.6. Virginia Public School Educational Technology Grants Program established.

14 With such funds as are appropriated for this purpose, the Virginia Public School Educational Technology Grants Program, hereinafter referred to as "the Program," is hereby established to provide 15 grants to eligible school divisions for educational technology, including infrastructure, software, and 16 17 hardware acquisitions and replacement, and innovative programs to advance the effectiveness of 18 educational technology. The Program shall be administered by the Board of Education. 19

§ 22.1-175.7. Virginia Public School Educational Technology Trust Fund created.

20 A. From such funds as may be appropriated for this purpose and from such gifts, donations, grants, bequests, and other funds as may be received on its behalf, there is hereby created in the Department of 21 the Treasury a special nonreverting fund known as the Virginia Public School Educational Technology 22 Trust Fund, hereinafter referred to as "the Fund." The Fund shall be established on the books of the 23 24 Comptroller, and any moneys remaining in such Fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the 25 general fund but shall remain in the Fund. Interest earned on such funds shall remain in the Fund and be credited to it. Funds may be disbursed to any school division that is eligible for financial assistance 26 27 pursuant to the provisions of this chapter.

28 B. The State Treasurer shall manage the Virginia Public School Educational Technology Trust Fund, 29 subject to the authority of the Board of Education to provide for its disbursement. The Fund shall be 30 disbursed to award grants as provided in § 22.1-175.6.

31 C. The amount of such educational technology grants shall be matched by funds of the qualifying 32 school division based on the locality's composite index of ability to pay. In awarding such grants, the 33 Board shall take into consideration any other state or federal grants which may have been applied for 34 or awarded for the same projects. In addition, the Board shall assist local school divisions in applying 35 for such grants and shall seek to ensure that all divisions have equitable access, based on 36 superintendent's regions, to such funds as may be available.

37 § 22.1-175.8. Board to issue guidelines.

38 The Board shall issue guidelines for the administration of the Program as it may deem necessary 39 and appropriate. The guidelines shall include, but shall not be limited to, provisions which address 40 compliance with other law or Board requirements for educational technology, the application for a 41 grant from the Fund, the innovations included in the proposal, and other criteria as established by the 42 Board.

43 § 22.1-175.9. Funding.

44 Grants pursuant to this chapter shall be awarded upon a determination of the Governor of the 45 appropriate funding source and amounts for the Fund established in § 22.1-175.7.

Funds appropriated for financial assistance for the purposes of this chapter shall be apportioned and 46 47 distributed among the school divisions of the Commonwealth in accordance with eligibility and needs 48 criteria to be established by the Board.
