The amount of municipal solid waste received at any landfill authorized to accept such waste 14 shall not exceed 2,000 tons per day, or the average actual amount of municipal solid waste received by such landfill on a daily basis during 1998, as reported to the Department of Environmental Quality 15 pursuant to § 10.1-1413.1, whichever is greater, unless the landfill has received approval from the 16 Director pursuant to subsection B for a larger tonnage allotment.
