3	A BILL to amend and reenact § 28.2-302.8 of the Code of Virginia, relating to recreational saltwater
4	fishing.

10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 28.2-302.8 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 28.2-302.8. Headboat or charterboat; rental boats.
13	A. The Commission may establish [and limit] the sale of a fishing guide license. If established,
14	such fishing guide license shall be required for each charterboat and headboat captain. [The
15	Commission may limit the sale of such licenses to nonresidents when deemed necessary by the
16	Commission for effective fisheries management.] The application for the license shall include a copy of
17	the applicant's current U.S. Coast Guard license permitting him to carry passengers for hire. The fee for
18	the license shall not exceed \$ 100. The Commission may reduce the fee charged for the saltwater
19	recreational fishing license under subsection B by an amount equal to the fee for the fishing guide
20	license.
21	A. B. The owner of a headboat or charterboat annually shall purchase a recreational fishing license
22	which covers his customers to meet the requirements set forth in § 28.2-302.1. The annual cost of the
23	license shall be \$150 for uninspected vessels licensed by the United States Coast Guard to carry six
24	fishing passengers or fewer and, for boats United States Coast Guard certified to carry a number of
25	fishing passengers greater than six, \$150 plus \$4 for each passenger over six for which the boat is
26	designed.
27	\mathbf{B} . C. The owner of a boat rental service shall purchase a recreational fishing license which covers
28	his customers to meet the requirements set forth in § 28.2-302.1. The annual cost of the license shall be
29	\$7.50 per boat with a maximum fee of \$500, whichever is less.
30	C. D. Charterboat and headboat operators shall report such data as are deemed necessary by the
31	Commission for the effective fisheries management as a condition of issuance of the license.
