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12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 38.2-3407.1:1 as follows:
14	§ 38.2-3407.1:1. Interest on accident and sickness claim proceeds; escrow accounts.
15	A. Within fifteen working days from the insurer's receipt of proof of loss, an insurer shall (i) pay the
16	claim or (ii) place into an interest-bearing demand escrow account, an amount equal to the usual and
17	customary fees charged for the services rendered.
18	B. This section shall not apply to claims for which payment has been or will be made directly to
19	health care providers pursuant to a negotiated reimbursement arrangement requiring uniform or
20	periodic interim payments to be applied against the insurer's obligation on such claims.
21	C. All interest earned from the money placed in escrow pursuant to subsection A shall be paid
22	annually to the Virginia Indigent Health Care Trust Fund established pursuant to Chapter 11
23	(§ 32.1-332 et seq.) of Title 32.1. Contributions to the Fund by insurers shall be made once annually in
24	January of each calendar year beginning in January 2000. The policy and details relating to receipt of
25	contributions shall be prescribed by the Board.
26	D. Any person who knowingly and willfully fails to pay in a timely manner the contribution to the
27	Fund required by this section shall be civilly liable in an amount not to exceed \$500 per incident. All

*penalties collected under this subsection shall be collected and remitted to the Virginia Indigent Health Care Trust Fund.* **2. That § 38.2-3407.1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.**
