### HOUSE BILL NO. 2697

#### AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE

(Proposed by the House Committee on Counties, Cities and Towns  
on February 6, 1999)

(Patrons Prior to Substitute—Delegates Byron and Ingram [HB 2105])

*A BILL to amend and reenact § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia, relating to truancy ordinances.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 15.2-926 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 15.2-926. Prohibiting loitering; curfew for minors; penalty.

Any locality may by ordinance prohibit loitering in, upon or around any public place, whether on public or private property. Any locality may by ordinance also prohibit minors who are not attended by their parents from frequenting or being in public places, whether on public or private property, at such times, between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., as the governing body deems proper.

A violation of such ordinance ~~ordinance~~ *ordinances* by a minor *shall constitute a Class 4 misdemeanor and* shall be disposed of as provided in §§ 16.1-278.4 and 16.1-278.5.
