Patron—Murphy 8 Referred to Committee on Transportation 9 10 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 33.1-221.1:6 and 58.1-815.3 11 12 as follows: 13 § 33.1-221.1:6. U.S. Route 3, Chesapeake Bay Byway Program. 14 A. The General Assembly declares it to be in the public interest that the economic development needs 15 and economic growth potential of the Northern Neck be addressed by a special transportation program to provide for the costs of providing an adequate, modern, safe and efficient transportation network in 16 the Northern Neck which shall be known as the "U.S. Route 3, Chesapeake Bay Byway Program," 17 hereafter called the Program, including, without limitation, environmental and engineering studies, 18 rights-of-way acquisition, construction, improvements to all modes of transportation, and financing costs. 19 20 B. Allocations to this Program from the U.S. Route 3, Chesapeake Bay Byway Development Fund 21 established by § 58.1-815.3 shall be made annually by the Commonwealth Transportation Board for the 22 creation and enhancement of a safe, efficient transportation system connecting the communities, 23 businesses, places of employment, historic sites, recreation areas, and residences of the Commonwealth, 24 thereby enhancing the economic development potential, employment opportunities, mobility and quality 25 of life in Virginia. 26 C. Allocations to the Program shall not diminish or replace allocations made from other sources or 27 diminish allocations to which any district, system, or locality would be entitled under other provisions of 28 this title, but shall be supplemental to other allocations to the end that transportation improvements in 29 Virginia may be accelerated and augmented. Allocations under this subsection shall be limited to 30 projects specified in subsection E of this section. 31 D. The Commonwealth Transportation Board may expend such funds from all sources as may be 32 lawfully available to initiate the Program. 33 E. The Program consists of certain improvements to, and contiguous to, Route 3 from Route 301 to 34 Route 14. 35 F. Notwithstanding § 33.1-62 of the Code of Virginia, that portion of Route 3 between Route 301 and 36 Route 14 shall be designated a Virginia byway and shall be called the Virginia Chesapeake Bay Byway. 37 § 58.1-815.3. U.S. Route 3, Chesapeake Bay Byway Development Fund. 38 There is hereby created in the Department of the Treasury a special nonreverting fund which shall 39 be a part of the Transportation Trust Fund and which shall be known as the "U.S. Route 3, Chesapeake Bay Byway Development Fund," hereafter called the Fund, consisting of ten million dollars of annual 40 41 collections of the state recordation taxes imposed by this chapter; however, this dedication shall not 42 affect the local recordation taxes under subsection B of § 58.1-802 and § 58.1-814. The Fund shall also include such other funds as may be appropriated by the General Assembly from time to time, and 43 designated for this Fund and all interest, dividends and appreciation which may accrue thereto. Any 44 moneys remaining in the Fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the general fund, but shall 45 remain in the Fund. Allocations from the Fund may be paid to any authority, locality or commission for 46 47 the purposes specified in § 33.1-221.1:6.
