Patron—Puller Referred to Committee on Rules 9 10 WHEREAS, renal dialysis is an important part of care for persons with chronic kidney disease; and WHEREAS, the Joint Commission on Health Care has previously reviewed the adequacy of state 11 oversight of other types of health care facilities; and 12 WHEREAS, the State Department of Health is the primary state regulator of health care facilities; 13 14 and WHEREAS, outpatient renal dialysis services provided within hospitals is currently regulated by the 15 16 State Department of Health under regulations promulgated by the State Board of Health; and WHEREAS, renal dialysis services are offered in a variety of settings; and 17 18 WHEREAS, consumer concern has been expressed regarding the adequacy of state oversight of 19 freestanding renal dialysis facilities; now, therefore, be it 20 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Joint Commission on Health 21 Care, with the assistance of the State Department of Health, be directed to examine (i) the adequacy of 22 current state oversight of freestanding renal dialysis facilities; (ii) needed changes, if any, to state law 23 and regulations; [ and (iii) the advisability of licensure of dialysis technicians; and (iv) ] other issues as 24 appropriate; and, be it 25 RÉSOLVED FURTHER, That all agencies of the Commonwealth shall cooperate fully with the joint
