10 11 12	WHEREAS, each year since 1977 a joint subcommittee consisting of members of the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee, and members of the House Labor and Commerce Committee has met
12	to study the funding requirements of the Virginia Unemployment Trust Fund; and
14	WHEREAS, such joint subcommittee met in 1998 pursuant to Senate Joint Resolution No. 77 (1998)
15 16	to review the current status and long-term projections for the Unemployment Trust Fund; and WHEREAS, the Unemployment Trust Fund is financed by Virginia's employers and drawn on by
17	working Virginians who become unemployed and must rely on such fund for unemployment
18 19	compensation benefits; and WUEPEAS continued logiclative everyight of such fund is werented to ensure its adequacy to meet
19 20	WHEREAS, continued legislative oversight of such fund is warranted to ensure its adequacy to meet current and projected benefit payments; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Joint Subcommittee
22	Studying the Funding Requirements of the Virginia Unemployment Trust Fund be hereby continued. The
23 24	Joint Subcommittee's membership shall remain the same, with any vacancies to be filled by the Speaker of the House and the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections, as appropriate.
25	The direct costs of this study shall not exceed \$3,000.
26	The Division of Legislative Services shall provide staff support for the study. All agencies of the
27 28	Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Joint Subcommittee upon request. The Joint Subcommittee shall complete its work in time to submit its findings and recommendations
2 9	to the Governor and the 2000 Session of the General Assembly as provided in the procedures of the
30	Division of Legislative Automated Systems for processing legislative documents.
31	Implementation of this resolution is subject to subsequent approval and certification by the Joint
32 33	Rules Committee. The Committee may withhold expenditures or delay the period for the conduct of the study.
