| 13 | § 6.1-378.3. Sale or issuance of bearer money orders; prohibition. |
| 14 | A. No licensee shall sell or issue, or allow its agents to sell or issue money orders that do not |
| 15 | designate a specific payee |

B. In addition to the license revocation provisions of § 6.1-374, a licensee violating any provision of this section shall be subject to injunction by the Commission or by a court of competent jurisdiction on motion of any party in interest, and shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$1,000 per day for

each day the violation continues.
