9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 46.2-870 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 46.2-870. Maximum speed limits generally.
12	Except as otherwise provided in this article, the maximum speed limit shall be fifty-five miles per
13	hour on interstate highways or other limited access highways with divided roadways, nonlimited access
14	highways having four or more lanes, and all state primary highways.
15	The maximum speed limit on all paved highways in the state secondary highway system whose
16	pavement is no more than eighteen feet wide shall be forty-five miles per hour.
17	The maximum speed limit on all other highways shall be fifty-five miles per hour if the vehicle is a
18	passenger motor vehicle, bus, pickup or panel truck, or a motorcycle, but forty-five miles per hour on
19	such highways if the vehicle is a truck, tractor truck, or combination of vehicles designed to transport
20	property, or is a motor vehicle being used to tow a vehicle designed for self-propulsion, or a house
21	trailer.
22	Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the maximum speed limits on (i) highways
23	constructed pursuant to the Virginia Highway Corporation Act of 1988 (§ 56-535 et seq.), (ii) those rural
24	interstate highways where both (a) permitted by federal laws and (b) indicated by lawfully placed signs,
25	and (iii) other limited access highways in any county having a population of at least 45,700 but no more

interstate highways where both (a) permitted by federal laws and (b) indicated by lawfully placed signs, and (iii) other limited access highways in any county having a population of at least 45,700 but no more than 45,800, where indicated by lawfully placed signs, shall be sixty-five miles per hour.
