11	1. That § 15.2-5102 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	A. The governing body of a locality may by ordinance or resolution, or the governing bodies of two
13	or more localities may by concurrent ordinances or resolutions or by agreement, create a water authority,
14 15	a sewer authority, a sewage disposal authority, a stormwater control authority, or a refuse collection and disposal authority are any combination or parts thereof. The name of the authority shall contain the word

10	"authority." The authority shall be a public body politic and corporate. The ordinance, resolution or agreement creating the authority shall not be adopted or approved until a public hearing has been held

20	B. Any authority, or any subsidiary thereof, organized pursuant to this section to operate a refuse
21	collection and disposal system that, pursuant to statute, is specifically authorized to include in the
$\overline{22}$	system (i) facilities for processing solid waste as a fuel, and (ii) facilities for generating steam and
23	electricity for sale, shall not be subject to regulation under the Utilities Facilities Act (§ 56-265.1 et
24	seq.), provided that sales of electricity generated at such facilities are made only to a federal agency
