7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

8 **1. That § 4 of Chapter 726 of the Acts of Assembly of 1990, and § 6 of Chapter 726 of the Acts of**
9 **Assembly of 1990 as amended by Chapter 228 of the Acts of Assembly of 1993, are amended and**
10 **reenacted as follows:**

11 § 4. Members.

12 The Authority shall consist of ~~seven~~ *fourteen* members, unless increased as provided for herein, who
13 are to be appointed *or shall serve* as follows:

14 1. One member to be appointed by the Board of supervisors of the County of Charles City, Virginia,
15 *and the sheriff of the County;*

16 2. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Chesterfield, Virginia,
17 *and the sheriff of the County;*

18 3. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Colonial Heights, *Virginia, and*
19 *the sheriff of the City;*

20 4. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Hopewell, Virginia, *and the*
21 *sheriff of the City;*

22 5. One member to be appointed by the City Council of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, *and the*
23 *sheriff of the City;*

24 6. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince George,
25 Virginia, *and the sheriff of the County;* and

26 7. One member to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Surry, Virginia, *and*
27 *the sheriff of the County.*

28 No member of the governing body of the County of Chesterfield, the County of Charles City, the
29 City of Colonial Heights, the City of Hopewell, the City of Petersburg, the County of Prince George, or
30 the County of Surry may be a member of the Authority.

31 All *nonsheriff* members of the Authority shall serve for a term of four years. The initial term of
32 office shall extend from the organizational meeting of the Authority until the Authority's annual meeting
33 four years thereafter. Any *nonsheriff* member of the Authority may be appointed to succeed himself.
34 Each duly appointed *nonsheriff* member shall hold office until his successor shall be duly appointed.
35 Any vacancy in the *nonsheriff* membership of the Authority, whether caused by expiration of term of
36 office, death, resignation, or otherwise, shall be filled by the governing body of the city or county which
37 appointed the member whose membership is then vacant. Any member appointed to fill an unexpired
38 term shall serve only until the expiration of the term he was appointed to fill. *Sheriffs shall serve a term*
39 *coexistent with their term as sheriff.*

40 *Notwithstanding any other provision of law, special or general, alternate members may be appointed*
41 *to the Authority by the governing body of the city or county in the same manner as regular members. If*
42 *a regular member is not present at the meeting of the Authority, the alternate for that member shall*
43 *have all the voting and other rights of a regular member and shall be counted for purposes of*
44 *determining a quorum at any meeting. Alternates may not be appointed for the sheriff members of the*
45 *Authority.*

46 § 6. Voting.

47 A majority of the members of the Authority shall constitute a quorum. A majority of the quorum is
48 empowered to exercise all of the rights and perform all of the duties of the Authority, except where
49 specifically provided otherwise herein or by agreement between the Authority and the participating
50 jurisdictions, and no vacancy on the Authority shall impair the right of the quorum to act. *In the event*
51 *such agreement requires the affirmative vote of the jurisdictions holding a majority of prisoners in the*
52 *jail for certain actions to be effective, the vote of the members appointed by the governing bodies or*
53 *their alternates shall be the only votes counted for such purposes.*
