## SENATE BILL NO. 1260

Offered January 21, 1999

*A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 3.1-796.128:2, relating to selling garments containing dog fur; penalty.*

### **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 3.1-796.128:2 as follows:**

*§ 3.1-796.128:2. Selling garments containing dog fur prohibited.*

*It is unlawful for any person to knowingly sell a garment containing the hide, fur or pelt of a dog. A violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000.*
