SENATE BILL NO. 1260

Senate Amendments in [] — February 4, 1999

A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 3.1-796.128:2, relating to selling garments containing dog fur; penalty.

Referred to Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 3.1-796.128:2 as follows:

§ 3.1-796.128:2. Selling garments containing dog fur prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person to knowingly sell a garment containing the hide, fur or pelt of a [domestic] dog [or cat]. A violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000.
