| 12 | 1. That § 32.1-17of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                             |
| 13 | § 32.1-17. Appointment of Commissioner; qualifications; term.                                             |
| 14 | A. There shall be a State Health Commissioner appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation          |
| 15 | by each house of the General Assembly. The Commissioner shall be a physician licensed to practice         |
| 16 | medicine in this Commonwealth and shall be certified by the American Board of Preventive Medicine or      |
| 17 | a recognized board in a primary care specialty, experienced in public health duties, sanitary science and |
| 18 | environmental health, and otherwise qualified to execute the duties incumbent upon him by law.            |
| 19 | B. The Commissioner shall be appointed for a term coincident with that of the Governor and shall          |
