11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 46.2-743 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for certain veterans.
14	A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
15	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
16	applicant special license plates.
17 18	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an on active duty with, has
10 19	been honorably discharged after at least two years of active duty service in, or has retired member of from the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the
20	applicant special license plates whose design incorporates an emblem of the military service of which
20 21	the applicant is an active duty or retired member.
22	C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
23	the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II.
24	D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
25	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War.
26	E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
27	War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War.
28	F. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
29	Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans
30	of those military operations.
31	G. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license

of those military operations. G. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under subsection A, C, D, or E of this section. 32
