234567 WHEREAS, Joan G. Rokus, a retired teacher, community activist, and seven-year member of the 8 Loudoun County Board of Supervisors from the Leesburg district, announced on January 11, 1999 that 9 she would not seek a third term on the board of supervisors; and

10 WHEREAS, with a public-service career spanning three decades, Joan Rokus is best known for her 11 work in historic preservation and with parks and recreation in Loudoun County, helping to form Keep Loudoun Beautiful, the Mount Zion Church Preservation Society, and the Friends of the Stone House at 12 13 Harper Park; and

14 WHEREAS, as Loudoun's representative to the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority and the 15 board of supervisor's liaison to the Loudoun County Parks, Recreation and Community Advisory 16 Services Board, Joan Rokus' work has had a region-wide influence; and

WHEREAS, a Loudoun County resident since 1965, Joan Rokus has served on dozens of boards and 17 committees, including Leadership Loudoun, the Loudoun County Volunteer Board, the Business and 18 Professional Women's Club, and the Loudoun United Way Executive Board; and 19
