2 *An Act to award a service handgun to the widow of Trooper Troy D. Ashe.*

5 Whereas, Trooper Troy D. Ashe served the Commonwealth of Virginia as a Deputy Sheriff in
6 Middlesex County from November 1991 until July 31, 1993; and7 Whereas, Trooper Ashe served the Commonwealth as a Marine Patrol Officer with the Virginia
8 Marine Resources Commission from August 1, 1993, until November 30, 1995; and9 Whereas, Trooper Ashe served the Commonwealth as a Trooper with the Virginia Department of
10 State Police from December 1, 1995, until April 15, 1999; and

11 Whereas, Trooper Ashe received numerous commendations during his law enforcement career; and

12 Whereas, Trooper Ashe was killed in an accident on April 15, 1999; and

13 Whereas, it is fitting and appropriate that Trooper Troy D. Ashe's exceptional service to the
14 Commonwealth be recognized by the General Assembly; now, therefore,15 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**16 1. § 1. *That Jennifer M. Ashe, the widow of Trooper Troy D. Ashe, be, and hereby is, vested with title*
17 *to, and authorized to possess and retain as her own, Trooper Troy D. Ashe's service handgun, which he*
18 *used as a member of the Virginia Department of State Police. This transfer is made as a visible and*
19 *express token of the appreciation of the General Assembly for the professionalism, devotion, and*
20 *dedication of Trooper Troy D. Ashe.*
