6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That Chapter 865 of the Acts of Assembly of 1999 is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 1. The governing body of any town with a population between 14,000 and 15,000 may by
9 ordinance (i) prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle at a speed of twenty miles ~~an~~ per hour or more
10 in excess of the applicable maximum speed limit in a residence district and (ii) provide that any person
11 who violates the prohibition shall be subject to a mandatory civil penalty of \$100, not subject to
12 suspension.

13 § 2. *The governing body of any city with a population between 9,000 and 11,000 may by ordinance*
14 *(i) prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle at a speed of fifteen miles per hour or more in excess of*
15 *the applicable maximum speed limit in a residence district, as defined in § 46.2-100 of the Code of*
16 *Virginia, when indicated by appropriately placed signs displaying the maximum speed limit and the*
17 *penalty for violations, and (ii) provide that any person who violates the prohibition shall be subject to a*
18 *civil penalty of \$100, in addition to other penalty provided by law.*
