234567 A BILL to amend and reenact Chapter 865 of the Acts of Assembly of 1999, relating to the authority of certain localities to adopt ordinances prohibiting speeding in residence districts; penalty. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. That Chapter 865 of the Acts of Assembly of 1999 is amended and reenacted as follows:

- § 1. The governing body of any town with a population between 14,000 and 15,000 may by ordinance (i) prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle at a speed of twenty miles an *per* hour or more 10 11 in excess of the applicable maximum speed limit in a residence district and (ii) provide that any person 12 who violates the prohibition shall be subject to a mandatory civil penalty of \$100, not subject to 13 14 suspension.
- 15 2. The governing body of any city with a population between 9,000 and 11,000 may by ordinance 16 (i) prohibit the operation of a motor vehicle at a speed of fifteen miles per hour or more in excess of 17 the applicable maximum speed limit in a residence district, as defined in § 46.2-100 of the Code of
- 18 Virginia, when indicated by appropriately placed signs displaying the maximum speed limit and the

penalty for violations, and (ii) provide that any person who violates the prohibition shall be subject to a 19 civil penalty of \$100, in addition to other penalty provided by law. 20
