| 9 | 1. That § 46.2-803.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 10 | § 46.2-803.1. Commercial vehicles limited to use of certain lanes of certain interstate highways. |
| 11 | Except when necessary to exit the highway via a left exit or where the posted speed limit is less than |
| 12 | sixty-five miles per hour, no person shall drive any commercial motor vehicle, as defined in |
| 13 | § 46.2-341.4, on the left-most of any interstate highway having more than two lanes in each direction |
| 14 | except on one of the two right-most lanes thereof. |
| 15 | Furthermore, within the eighth planning district, no person shall drive any commercial motor |
| 16 | vehicle, as defined in § 46.2-341.4, on the left-most lane of any interstate highway having more than two |
| 17 | lanes in each direction, regardless of the posted speed limit. |
| 18 | The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) buses or school buses or (ii) other commercial |

or construction work on an interstate highway or to buses or school buses.
