CHAPTER 51.

ASIAN-AMERICAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER ADVISORY COUNCIL.

§ 9-390. Asian-American and Pacific Islander Advisory Council established; purpose.

The Asian-American and Pacific Islander Advisory Council (the "Council") is hereby established as an advisory council within the meaning of § 9-6.25 in the executive branch of state government. The purpose of the Council shall be to advise the Governor on the issues of concern to Asian-American and Pacific Islanders in the Commonwealth.

§ 9-391. Membership; terms; chairman; compensation.

The Council shall consist of eleven members to be appointed by the Governor as follows: ten citizen members, who shall be residents of the Commonwealth and one member from the Department of Social

Of the initial appointments, four members shall serve four-year terms; four members shall serve three-year terms; and three members shall serve two-year terms. Thereafter, all members shall serve four-year terms. Vacancies occurring other than by expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term in the manner of the original appointment. Any member may be reappointed for successive terms.

The Governor shall appoint the chairman of the Council from among its membership. A majority of the Council shall constitute a quorum. The Council shall meet at least quarterly or upon the call of the chairman.

Members of the Council shall receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties as provided in § 2.1-20.8.

§ 9-392. Duties of the Council.

The Board shall gather information and data in order to accomplish its purposes as set forth in § 9-390, and to formulate and present its recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly. § 9-393. Staff; cooperation from other state agencies.

The Department of Social Services shall serve as staff to the Council. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall assist the Council, upon request.
