12	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
13	1. §1. The provisions of this act shall apply to the November 6, 2001, elections for members of the
14	House of Delegates of Virginia, for constitutional officers, for members of county governing bodies, and
15	for members of county school boards.
16	§2. The State Board of Elections shall be authorized to reschedule the June 12, 2001, primary date
17	for these offices to any Tuesday after June 12, 2001, and not later than September 11, 2001, if it
18	appears that the necessary 2001 reapportionment or redistricting will not be completed, and pre-clearance
19	from the appropriate United States authority under § 5 of the United States Civil Rights Act will not be
20	received, in time for those primaries to be held on June 12, 2001.
21	§3. The new primary date set by the State Board of Elections shall not be less than thirty days after
22	the Board votes, in open meeting, to set such new date. The State Board of Elections may vote, no later
23	than May 12, 2001, to postpone the June 12, 2001, primary for these offices without deciding a new
24 25	date. Any meeting called for the purpose of postponing the primary date or setting a new primary date
25 26	may not be called with less than seven-days notice to the public and the interested parties. The State Board of Elections shall, at the same time that it sets the new primary date, approve a revised schedule
20 27	of filing dates for such primary and specify which previously filed documents shall continue to be
21 70	or ming dates for such primary and specify which previously free documents shall continue to be

acceptable despite their referencing the June 12, 2001, primary date. §4. If the primary is held later than August 1, 2001, ballots for the November 2001 election shall be **29** 30 printed on or before Friday, October 5, 2001, or as soon thereafter as practicable, notwithstanding § 24.2-612.2. That the provisions of this act shall expire on January 1, 2002. 31
