13	1. § 1. That notwithstanding any law to contrary, the Department of Mental Health, Mental
14	Retardation and Substance Abuse Services is hereby authorized to [convey to (i) enter into an annual
15	agreement with] Amherst County, upon terms and conditions the Department deems proper [and until
16	such time as the property is sold or converted to another use by the Commonwealth], with the
17	approval of the Governor and in a form approved by the Attorney General, [(i) which agreement shall
18	provide for the use by Amherst County of] a fifty-foot right-of-way on property owned by the
19 20	Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services and referred to as tax map parcel 160-A-69, beginning at the intersection with State Route 334 and the private road leading to
20 21	the county sewer pump station and following said private road in a southeasterly direction to its point
$\frac{21}{22}$	of intersection with property described in Deed Book 486, page 364, and (ii) [convey] a one
$\frac{1}{23}$	hundred-foot right-of-way running along the James River, beginning at the northwest corner of the
24	property owned by the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services
25	and referred to as tax map parcel 160-A-69, and continuing southeasterly to the end of said property.
26	§ 2. The appropriate officials of the Commonwealth are hereby authorized to prepare, execute and
27	deliver such deed [, agreement] or other documents as may be necessary to accomplish the [
28	conveyance requirements of § 1 of this Act].
