CHAPTER 52.

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VIRGINIA RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY ADVISORY COMMISSION.

- 136 § 9-396. Commission established; purpose.
- The Virginia Research and Technology Advisory Commission (Commission) is established as an 137 138 advisory commission within the meaning of \S 9-6.25, in the executive branch of state government. The 139 purpose of the Commission shall be to advise the Governor on appropriate research and technology 140 strategies for the Commonwealth with emphasis on policy recommendations that will enhance the global 141 competitive advantage of both research institutions and technology-based commercial endeavors within 142 the Commonwealth. 143
 - § 9-397. Membership; terms; vacancies; chairman.
- 144 A. Persons appointed to the Board shall be selected for their knowledge of, background in, or 145 experience with basic and applied research, emerging technologies, commercialization of the results and 146 outputs of research activities, and the development and financing of technology intensive enterprises.
- 147 B. The Commission shall consist of twenty-seven members to be appointed as follows: two members 148 of the House Committee on Science and Technology appointed by the Speaker of the House; the 149 chairman of the Senate Committee on General Laws or his designee; and twenty citizen members 150 representing institutions of higher education, federal laboratories, and research- and 151 technology-intensive industries, six of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House, four of 152 whom shall be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections, and ten of whom shall be appointed by the Governor; the Secretaries of Commerce and Trade, Education, and Technology, or 153 154 their designees; and the Director of the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia or her designee. 155 Legislative members shall be appointed to serve terms coincident with their terms of office. The citizen 156 members shall be appointed for terms of four years, except that appointments to fill vacancies shall be 157 for the unexpired term. Vacancies shall be filled in the manner of the original appointments.
- 158 C. The Governor shall designate one member representing Virginia's research universities and one 159 member representing the private sector as cochairs.
- 160 D. A majority of the members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum. Commission meetings 161 shall be upon the call of the cochairs.
- 162 E. Members of the Commission shall receive compensation and be entitled to be reimbursed for all 163 reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties as provided in §§ 2.1-20.3, 164 2.1-20.8, 2.1-20.10, and 30-19.12.
- 165 § 9-398. Powers and duties of the Commission.
- 166 The Commission shall:
- 167 1. Undertake studies and gather information and data in order to accomplish its purposes as set 168 forth in § 9-396, and to formulate and present its recommendations to the Governor and the General 169 Assembly;
- 170 2. Make recommendations upon all proposals submitted to the Grant Allocation Committee, as 171 described in subdivision J 5 b of Item 548 of the 2000 Appropriation Act, Chapter 1073 of the 2000 172 Acts of Assembly, for grant allocations to be disbursed from the Commonwealth Technology Research 173 Fund created by subdivision J 1 of Item 548 of the 2000 Appropriation Act;
- 174 3. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from public, quasi-public or private 175 sources and state funds that may be appropriated by the General Assembly to carry out its purpose; and 176 4. Report annually its findings and recommendations to the Governor. The Commission may make
- 177 interim reports to the Governor as it deems advisable.
- 178 § 9-399. Funding for Commission's activities.

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- Funding necessary to support the Commission's work, including but not limited to the compensation and reimbursement pursuant to subsection E of § 9-397, shall be provided by the Innovative Technology Authority and other sources pursuant to subdivision 2 of § 9-398. § 9-400. Staff; cooperation from other state agencies. The Innovative Technology Authority shall provide staff support to the Commission. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall assist the Commission upon request.
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
