**HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 763** 1 2 Offered January 17, 2001 3 Memorializing Congress to reinstate full medical benefits for veterans aged 65 and older. 4 Patrons-Harris, Albo, Almand, Barlow, Black, Blevins, Bloxom, Bolvin, Broman, Byron, Councill, Cox, Cranwell, Crittenden, Darner, Day, Devolites, Diamonstein, Dickinson, Drake, Griffith, Hall, Hamilton, Hargrove, Howell, Ingram, Jones, J.C., Jones, S.C., Katzen, Landes, Larrabee, Louderback, Marshall, May, McClure, McQuigg, Melvin, Morgan, Nixon, O'Bannon, O'Brien, Orrock, Parrish, Plum, Purkey, Rapp, Reid, Robinson, Rollison, Rust, Scott, Sherwood, Suit, Tata, Thomas, Van Yahres, Wardrup, Ware, Weatherholtz, Welch and Wright 5 6 Referred to Committee on Militia and Police 7 8 WHEREAS, the Commonwealth and the General Assembly recognize and acknowledge the 9 contributions of veterans to our democratic system and to the freedoms we all enjoy; and 10 WHEREAS, retired veterans, those aged 65 and older, served during foreign crises of the 20th century at such places as the Ardennes, Kasserine Pass, Guadalcanal, Tarawa, Normandy, Bastogne, 11 Anzio, and Iwo Jima; and 12 WHEREAS, they also served during the Korean War at Inchon and the Chosin Reservoir, and in 13 14 Vietnam at DaNang, Khe Sanh, and Quang Tri; and 15 WHEREAS, these retired veterans now constitute a significant portion of the senior population of the 16 United States and, in particular, of Virginia; and 17 WHEREAS, the retired veterans were guaranteed through contract, both stated and implied, lifetime 18 access to medical benefits for themselves and their immediate family members upon retirement from the 19 armed services with 20 years or more of service; and 20 WHEREAS, prior to their own retirement at age 65, these veterans were provided health care 21 through the military health care system or through other U.S. Department of Defense programs; and 22 WHEREAS, through recent federal regulatory changes in entitlements for military health care 23 benefits, these older veterans and their family members have lost significant portions of their health care 24 support system; and 25 WHEREAS, the medical benefits, which were lost through changes to federal legislation, forced these 26 veterans to pay out-of-pocket for medical coverage from alternative sources and to join omnibus national 27 health programs, such as Medicare; and 28 WHEREAS, many veteran retirees and their immediate families live on fixed incomes, and the loss 29 of medical benefits significantly impacts their quality of life, disrupts their needed levels of care, and 30 puts out of reach certain health care benefits and pharmaceutical support to which they had previously 31 been entitled; and 32 WHEREAS, many of these veteran retirees, still suffering from service-connected injuries and serious 33 illnesses, have found their access to medical treatment facilities limited by downsizing or, in some rural 34 areas, elimination of needed facilities; and 35 WHEREAS, these honorable men and women, who have served and sacrificed in the uniformed 36 service of this nation, are deserving of the health care programs that they were guaranteed when they 37 completed 20 years or more of service; and 38 WHEREAS, the General Assembly has a special charge to safeguard and maintain the quality of life 39 for its citizens who have served and earned retirement benefits from military service; now, therefore, be 40 it RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 41 42 urge the Congress to reinstate full medical benefits for those qualified veterans who have reached age 65 43 or over; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit copies of this resolution 44 45 to the President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, and the members of the Virginia Congressional delegation so that 46 they may be apprised of the sense of the General Assembly of Virginia. 47
