**5. Summary/Purpose:** The bill provides that the Virginia Marine Resources Commission may allow construction of erosion control structures in the Baylor survey where it finds, along with other prescribed criteria, the proposed project to be technically and environmentally acceptable, unless the Baylor ground is productive, in which case the environmentally preferable erosion control shall be utilized. Under current law, the criterion is that such projects must be technically and environmentally preferable. The Baylor survey defines the boundaries of the natural oyster beds, rocks, and shoals of the Commonwealth.
