4. Title People with disabilities.

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill alters the composition of the Virginia Board for People with Disabilities (VBPD) to reflect changes in the federal Developmental Disabilities Assistance and Bill of Rights Act. VBPD is referred to as the State Council on Developmental Disabilities in federal law. Federal legislation recently passed by Congress would require that at least 60 percent of VBPD's membership consist of consumer members. This legislation would not change the total number of members but rather, the distribution of members between those representing consumer/family members and representatives from the community.

This bill changes the designation of some entities that shall be represented on the Virginia Board for People with Disabilities. The bill deletes a designation of a representative of a higher education training facility, a real estate interest, and two at-large members. Added are representatives of a high-technology interest, a banking executive, and four additional persons with developmental disabilities or parents or guardians of such persons. The bill also contains technical amendments.
