5. **Summary/Purpose:** The bill would authorize the Virginia Tourism Authority to update a travel guide for the disabled in the first year of every biennium beginning in FY 2003.

8. **Fiscal implications:** The bill would authorize, but not require, the Virginia Tourism Authority to update a travel guide for the disabled in the first year of every biennium beginning in FY 2003. The Authority estimates that it would cost at least \$225,000 in order to complete such an update. There is currently an update in process that is being funded from \$75,000 provided in Chapter 1073, the 2000 Appropriation Act, \$75,000 from the Authority's cooperative advertising program, and private matching funds raised for this purpose.
