4. Title 'No wake' buoys

5. Summary/Purpose: This bill precludes the removal of "no wake" buoys that were in place before July 1, 2001, unless they no longer serve the intended purpose related to the safe and efficient operation of vessels pursuant to any local ordinance. The bill also clarifies that localities can enact "no wake" ordinances in order to protect public safety or prevent erosion, or both. This legislation applies only to counties adjacent to Smith Mountain Lake - Franklin, Pittsylvania, and Bedford Counties.
