Department in a format prescribed by the Department. This application shall designate whether grant
funds provided under this Item will be used for purposes of operating support or capital outlay. Unless
otherwise specified in this Item, the matching amounts for grants funded from this Item may be in cash
or in-kind contributions as requested by the nonstate organization in its application for state grant funds.
The Department shall use applicable federal guidelines in assessing the value of in-kind contributions to
