That § 51.1-155 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 51.1-155. Service retirement allowance. A. Retirement allowance A member shall receive an annual retirement allowance, payable for life, as follows: 1. Normal retirement The allowance shall equal 1.70 percent of his average final compensation multiplied by the amount of his creditable service. 2. Early retirement; applicable to teachers, state employees, and certain others The allowance shall be determined in the same manner as for normal retirement if the member has less than thirty years of service at retirement, the amount of the retirement date precedes the earlier of (i) his normal retirement date proceeds the carlier of (i) his normal retirement date or (ii) the first date on which he would have completed a total of thirty years of creditable service. The provisions of this subdivision shall apply to teachers and state employees. Active members of the General Assembly who are eligible to receive a retirement allowance under 61 this title, excluding their service as a member of the General Assembly, shall be eligible to receive a 62 retirement allowance based on their creditable service and average final compensation for service other 63 than as a member of the General Assembly. Such members of the General Assembly shall continue to 64 be reported as any other members of the retirement system. Upon ceasing to serve in the General 65 Assembly, members of the General Assembly receiving a retirement allowance based on their creditable service and average final compensation for service other than as a member of the General Assembly 66 shall have their retirement allowance recomputed prospectively to include their service as a member of 67 the General Assembly. Active members of the General Assembly shall be prohibited from receiving a **68** service retirement allowance under this title based solely on their service as a member of the General 69 70 Assembly.

71 3. (Expires July 1, 2006) Any person receiving a service retirement allowance under this chapter, who is hired as a local school board instructional or administrative employee required to be licensed by 72 the Board of Education, may elect to continue to receive the retirement allowance during such 73 74 employment, under the following conditions:

(a) a. The person's retirement allowance is based in whole or in part on service as a local school 75 76 board instructional or administrative employee required to be licensed by the Board of Education; [and 77]

78 (b) b. The person has been receiving such retirement allowance for a certain period of at least thirty 79 days of time preceding his employment as provided by law; and

80 (c) The person is not receiving a retirement benefit pursuant to an early retirement incentive program from any local school division within the Commonwealth; and 81

82 (d) c. At the time the person is employed, the position to which he is assigned is among those 83 identified by the Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to subdivision 4 of § 22.1-23; and

84 d. The person is hired pursuant to a contract that does not exceed one year in duration [-; and] 85

[e. The person hired may only be employed for a single year period.]

If the person elects to continue to receive the retirement allowance during the period of such 86 87 employment, then his service performed and compensation received during such period of time will not 88 increase, decrease, or affect in any way his retirement benefits before, during, or after such employment.

2. That the second enactment of Chapters 689 and 700 of the Acts of Assembly of 2001 are 89 90 repealed.
