Commending Delmus Coley.

WHEREAS, Delmus Coley, the starting running back for the Floyd E. Kellam High School football team of Virginia Beach, experienced a record-setting 2001 season; and

WHEREAS, in the regular season, Delmus Coley rushed for 2,029 yards and scored 24 touchdowns and, including the postseason, carried the ball 279 times and gained 2,238 yards; and

WHEREAS, with those yards and carries, Delmus Coley did not fumble the ball once; and

WHEREAS, in a game against Landsdown High School, Delmus Coley set a new Beach District single game rushing record when he gained 340 yards on 22 carries; and

WHEREAS, in honor of his outstanding season, Delmus Coley was named to the All-Beach District, All-Tidewater, All-Eastern Region, and All-State teams as a running back; and

WHEREAS, Delmus Coley was named the co-offensive player of the year in the Beach District; and WHEREAS, in addition to his personal records, Delmus Coley led the Kellam High School Knights to a record of 10—2 and a place in the regional finals, the best football season in school history; and

WHEREAS, Delmus Coley is a leader on and off the field, a dedicated student-athlete who contributes to his community; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly commend Kellam High School running back Delmus Coley for his leadership and his record-breaking 2001 season; and, be it
