5. Summary/Purpose:

Thisbillchangestheconditionsunderwhichretiredteachersarepermittedtoreturnto teaching without interrupting their retirement benefits by (i) permitting such even if there tiree isreceivingretirementbenefitsfromanearlyretirementincentiveprogram,(ii)specifyingthat suchretireesmusthavebeenreceivingretirementbenefitsforaperiodof atleast30days beforereturningtoateachingposition, and (iii) requiring that the teacher behired pursuant toacontractthatdoesnotexceedoneyearinduration.Theteacherreturningtoworkunder thisprovisionmayonlyworkforoneyearaft erreturning.Currentlaw(i)prohibitssuch continuation of retirement benefits if any portion of the retirement benefits is based on an earlyretirementincentiveprogram,(ii)directstheJointLegislativeandAuditReview CommissionandtheBoardofT rusteesoftheVirginiaRetirementSystemtodeterminethe periodoftimeforeligibilitythataretireemusthavereceivedretirementbenefitsbefore returningtoteach; and (iii) does not specify the duration of the teacher's contract. The period thatateachermusthavebeenretiredundercurrentlawwasdeterminedtobeoneyear.
