HB426providesadditionalbondfundingof\$29milliontotheNorthernVirginiaTransportationDistrict Program.Accordingtothedepartment,thereshouldbesufficientrevenueintheNorthernVirginia TransportationDistrictFundtosupporttheadditionaldebtservice,whichisestimatedtobe\$2,254,000 annually.IntheNorthernVirginiaTransportationDistrictProgram,revenuebondsarefundedthrough designatedannualcollectionsofthestaterecordationtaxe sinthecountiesthatarepartofthedistrict. AccordingtotheDepartmentofTransportation,ifthisadditionalbondfundingisnotauthorizedto supporttheseprojects,thenfundingforotherlowerpriorityprojectsintheNorthernVirginia TransportationDistrictProgramcouldhavefundingdivertedfromthem.Thoseprojectsimpactedfirst willbeCategory4projects:"unnamed"projects.Category4projectsarefundedfromexcessrevenues afterVDOTcompletesprojectsunderCategories1and3asstat edinChapter538ofthe1999Actsof Assembly.
