Fiscalimplications: Although there was very little publicly -availableinformationaboutthe numberofpoliceofficer semployedbytheMetropolitanWashingtonAirportsAuthorityorits currentworkers' compensation practices, apotential guide to the Authority's costs of complyingwiththislegislationmaybefoundininformationcollectedbytheVirginia Workers' Compen sation Program, adivision of the Department of Human Resource Management, regarding the costs of serious hypertension -relatedhealtheventsreportedbythe Department of State Police's troopers. According to this information, the average cost of a serioushypertension -relatedhealtheventforaStatePolicetrooperis\$100,000.Inaddition, approximatelyonepercentofthatagency's officers will make hypertension -relatedworkers' compensation claims each year. However, since the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authorityisonlyboundbytheseprovisionsforaslongasitsowishestobeboundbythem, thatentitycouldrejectthislegislation. If this were to happen, the Authority would experience nofiscalimplicationsfromthisbill'spassage.
