4. Title LawOfficers'RetirementSystem;deputysheriffs.

5.Summary/Purpose:

Thisbillmakesdeputysheriffsmembersofthe VirginiaLawOfficers'RetirementSystem undercertainconditions, including the election of such by the respective sheriff. Funding for such memberships hall be provided by the Compensation Board.

6. Fiscalimpact:ThisbillallowsaSheriffto provide that all state funded deputy sheriffs in a locality will be members of VaLORS. The bill also provides that if the state funded positions are covered, then the locally funded positions will be covered as well. The bill provides that the Compensation Board will be arthecost of the benefits. The Compensation Board is currently limited in its cost by language in the Appropriations Act. If all Sheriffselect the coverage, the cost of coverage overwhat is reimbursable by the Compensation Board must be or neby the locality. The total cost for the benefits is approximately \$31.6 million in FY04. Currently, localities may provide special benefits for law enforcement of ficers with benefit sequivalent to those of state police of ficers (LEOS) to deputies. Seventy - three localities have made this election. If VaLORS is mandated at partial state expense, the cost for those localities will be reduced by the amount of state funding.

7. Budgetamendmentnecessary:Yes

8. Fiscal implications: Chapter 1073 of the 2000 Acts of Assembly requires the VRS to conduct actuarial valuations annually. The costs associated with this bill would accrue in FY03 and FY04, but would not be recognized in the employer contribution rates until FY04.

9. Specificagencyorp oliticalsubdivisionsaffected: VRS and participating cities and counties.
