4. Title Eminentdomain.

5. Summary/Purpose:

Repeals the enactment clause on procedures that we rescheduled to expire on July 1,2002. The provisions require that eminent domain valuation be determined by a panel of commissioners or a jury, with the majority of those listed for the jury pool being freeholders. The bill also 1) requires the condemnor to provide a copy of its appraisal of the property with its offert op urchase, 2) raises the limit for compensation for the survey, 3) requires the condemnor to conduct at itle search before making an offer, 4) requires that the condemnor use a certified general real estate appraiser, and 5) allows tenants whose lease term is 12 months or longer to intervene in the proceedings.
